By integrating the Zunder app with the Mobi.e system, users will have access to all public chargers in Portugal without having to alter their usual charging process with the Zunder app or eZCard.

Until now, the Portuguese model required electric vehicle users to download new apps different from those used in Spain, creating new profiles and adding new payment methods just to travel in Portugal. Alternatively, users had to arrange for traditional payment methods, such as specific payment cards for certain Portuguese operators. These inconveniences could lead to problems and errors for users unfamiliar with the system.
