Zunder opens Spains largest ultra-fast charging station at Parque Principado shopping center (Siero)



• The Zunder station located at the Parque Principado Shopping Center (Siero) is the largest ultrafast charging station in Spain.

- Strategically positioned along the north-south axis via the A-66 (Ruta de la Plata) and near the east-west A-8 axis, which, along with the AP-8, connects France with Galicia.
- This station offers 36 ultra-fast charging points with powers of up to 400kW, spacious parking spots, and all payment options.

Zunder, a leading operator for electric vehicles in Europe, today inaugurates Spain's largest ultra-fast charging station. Located at the Parque Principado Shopping Center in Siero (Asturias), the station features 36 charging points of up to 400kW, allowing users to charge their vehicle's battery in just a few minutes. With this new infrastructure, Zunder consolidates its position as the leading ultra-fast charging operator in Spain.

Located next to the A-66 motorway, this station is strategically placed along the Ruta de la Plata, a crucial northsouth route in Spain, and is close to the A-8, which connects the northern coast of Spain from the French border. The location not only makes this station a key point for electric mobility but also enhances connectivity between two of the country's primary economic and tourist axes. The inauguration was attended by several prominent figures, including María Belarmina Díaz, General Director of Energy and Mining for the Government of the Principality of Asturias; Ángel García, Mayor of Siero; and Daniel Pérez, CEO and Co-Founder of Zunder. With advanced technologies like Plug&Charge and multiple payment options such as the Zunder app or eZCard, the station provides a smooth, automated charging experience, making it a benchmark for ultra-fast charging in Spain and supporting the transition to more sustainable mobility. Zunder, recently named the leader in ultra-fast charging points in Spain for the second consecutive year according to El Español's ranking, reinforces its position as #1 with the opening of this new charging infrastructure.

Zunder's network plays a vital role in integrating the Principality of Asturias and the northern Spanish coastline into the national and European electric mobility map. By strengthening long-distance connections on key routes such as Gijón-Sevilla and between France and Galicia, Zunder is driving the expansion of infrastructure to facilitate electric vehicle mobility.

Currently, Zunder operates 82 charging points in Asturias:

- Tapia de Casariego: 2 CCS chargers of up to 150 kW for ultra-fast charging.
- Gijón: Charging stations at Viesques (1 CHAdeMO 50 kW, 1 CCS 50 kW, 1 Type 2 50 kW, 2 Type 2 slow), Marina Civil (2 CCS up to 100 kW, 2 CCS up to 25 kW), and Biblioteca del Campus (8 CCS up to 25 kW), offering up to 100 kW charging infrastructure.
- Langreo: Stations at Dolores Ibárruri (1 CCS up to 150 kW, 1 Type 2 22 kW, 1 CHAdeMO up to 80 kW) and Calle Aurelio Delbrouk (1 CCS up to 150 kW, 1 Type 2 22 kW, 1 CHAdeMO up to 80 kW).
- Universidad Oviedo: Milán Campus (2 CCS up to 100 kW), Llamaquique Campus (4 CCS up to 100 kW), Faculty of Economics and Business (2 CCS up to 100 kW), Faculty of Law (2 CCS up to 100 kW and 2 CCS up to 25 kW), and Faculty of Biology (2 Type 2 22 kW). At the Mieres Campus, there are charging points at the Research Building (2 CCS up to 96 kW and 2 CCS up to 100 kW) and the Residence Building (2 CCS up to 96 kW).
- Parque Principado Shopping Center: 12 CCS up to 400 kW and 24 CCS up to 160 kW, totaling 36 ultra-fast charging points, making it the largest ultra-fast charging station in Spain.

Daniel Pérez, CEO of Zunder, stated: "This station is another step in our mission to continue leading ultra-fast charging infrastructure in Spain, offering electric vehicle users advanced technology, reliability, and strategic locations."

María Belarmina Díaz, General Director of Energy and Mining for the Government of the Principality of Asturias, added: "Asturias is moving towards a more sustainable energy model thanks to projects like Zunder, which drive electric mobility and strengthen our position as leaders in the energy transition."

All users who charge at the Zunder station in Parque Principado will enjoy special prices for one month, offering improved rates.
